It also includes documentation from the Department of Defense, the Central Intelligence Agency, and the Kissinger papers.

U.S. government documents from this period show that Libya was the country with the most potential for problems in North Africa. United States officials recognized that it did not want to tie the U.S. to the authoritarian and corrupt monarchy of King Idris. The United States recognized the Revolutionary Command Council (RCC) as the new government after the September 1969 coup.

The documentation in this collection demonstrates that while Libya and the rest of North Africa was considered important enough for the United States to wish to retain the region in the western camp and prevent inroads into the area by the Soviet Union or Arab radicals, North Africa was not a high priority for U.S. foreign policy under President Richard Nixon.
